

Surgery Fees, Payments & Insurance

Your surgery bill for the center is **not** billed through Intermountain billing. Our facility utilizes our own billing department which allows us to process claims quickly.

We will bill your insurance based on information from your provider's office. An estimate will be sent to you before surgery via email or text. This estimate will show your scheduled procedure and what your anticipated patient responsibility will be based your insurance plan.

Patients are required to pay on the day of their appointment. We accept all credit, debit, HSA/ FSA cards. We also accept Care Credit. We do not accept cash payments.

Self pay accounts are required to pay in **full** prior to surgery to be eligible for the self pay discount.

If you need to discuss payment options or have questions regarding your estimate, our office team can assist you.

The surgical center fee includes:

- Equipment, supplies and anesthesia drugs used during surgery
- Services received in the recovery room

The facility fee does **not** include:

- Surgeon fees or Anesthesiologist fees
- Special supplies, equipment or drugs not specified in the initial evaluation



Preparing For Your Surgery

Prior to your surgery you will receive an online questionnaire and a call from Pre-Screening team (385-257-2687). During this call you will be instructed regarding your home medications on whether to continue or hold prior to surgery. Fasting guidelines are provided and your health history reviewed.

- Do not eat solid foods after 11:00pm the night before surgery **unless otherwise instructed by the Pre-Screening nurse.**
- Clear liquids (water, Gatorade, clear soda, black coffee) must be stopped 3 hours before your scheduled surgery **check-in time.**
- Morning medications that are approved to take on the day of surgery should be taken with a small sip of water.
- Do not drink alcohol or use marijuana products 24 hours prior to surgery.
- Do not use any nicotine, tobacco, or vaping products after 11:00pm the night before surgery. **If otherwise instructed by your physician please follow that information.**

You will receive a call from our Registration team the afternoon (or working day) prior to your surgery to confirm your check-in time and review general information. Calls begin at 2:00pm.

Transportation After Surgery

You must have a legal adult (18 yr or older) available to drive you home after surgery. Uber, Lyft or other Rideshare options are only permitted if a responsible adult is present with you.

If you develop a fever, cough or other medical problem prior to surgery please contact your providers office. Your surgery may need to be rescheduled based on their decision.

The Day Of Surgery

If you are unable to keep your appointment or are delayed, please contact us at 385.355.4200

Please wear loose fitting clothing. Do not wear makeup, perfume, jewelry or contact lenses.

When you arrive at the Surgery Center you will meet with the Registration team to complete patient forms and make any applicable payments on your account.

After registration, a member of our nursing team will escort you to the Pre-Op area. Your family/visitors (limit 2 per patient) may wait with you if you choose. Once you are taken back for surgery they will be asked to wait in our main lobby.

After Your Surgery

After surgery you will begin recovery in Phase 1 of the post-op area. Your family/visitors may join you during Phase 2 of recovery.

You will be provided with a snack and your nurse will provide post-op discharge instructions from your surgeon. You will be discharged to home once you have met the necessary criteria.

- **DO NOT** drink any alcohol for 24 hours after your surgery, or while you are taking prescribed pain medication.
- You will receive a post-op call after surgery to answer any questions or concerns you may have.
